Earlier, the Union Home Minister reached here in the summer capital along with his wife Savitri Singh, who too will participate in Pratham Puja along with the Housband at the holy cave along with the Governor N N Vohra.

Rajnath will be the first Union Home Minister to perform Pratham Puja, which marks the formal commencement of annual pilgrimage, at the cave tomorrow.

Interestingly, the Union Minister of State for Tourism and Culture Mahesh Sharma along with his close relatives including his mother and the top officials of a private airline today paid obeisance at the cave.

A large number of civil and army officials have already paid obeisance at the shrine while reviewing security and other arrangements.
